Introduction

Government College Birohar (Jhajjar) is located in rural vicinity, having lush green lawns, trees and a pollution free environment. The college embarked upon its journey in the year 2007 as Co-educational Institution. During its journey of over 17 years, the college has made tremendous progress on all fronts, be in education, extracurricular besides a variety of other fields. The college has strength of 880 students enrolled in the session 2023-24. The college is situated on Birohar - Khanchroli Road and in the West direction of District Jhajjar and East direction of city Charkhi Dadri. The college has its own occupied campus in the village - Birohar in district -Jhajjar. The college is recently included u/s 2(f) of UGC Act 1956 on dated 18-12-2023. The college has lush green ground, library, wellequipped Science Labs, Computer Labs, ICT classrooms and two spacious multipurpose Halls. The enriching study environment and the participative work culture govern the functioning of the college. The college administration and staff are committed to their work in order to meet the demands of changing educational requirements. The institution emphasizes on the all-round development of the students' personality so that they can meet the challenges of life with grit and confidence. The holistic development of students is the prime motto of the institution. Starting with the minimum requirements, the college has progressed by leaps and bounds and has undergone a complete transformation. During the last five years, the college has progressed in many spheres. The Post Graduate Programs are opting CBCS in M.A. History whereas Medical Science in B.Sc. has been introduced during the last five years. The physical infrastructure is augmented and maintained from time to time to provide physical facilities to the co-curricular/extracurricular students. Various activities are organized frequently and the students' participation is remarkable. The addition of innovative online learning modules is a forward step in the difficult time of unprecedented COVID-19 pandemic. The staff members are striving hard under the effective leadership of the worthy Principal and following the visionary policy guidelines given by MDU Rohtak & Directorate of Higher Education Haryana.

Staff

Out of 32 sanctioned posts, regular teachers are working on 15 seats, out of which, One Associate & Two Assistant Professor is on deputation to another colleges. The workload of the college is of 53 teachers and 10 extension lecturers are working in various subjects to make up for the shortfall. To manage the two computer labs efficiently, one computer instructor and one computer attendant are also working on contract basis.

The total sanctioned posts for the non-teaching staff are 17; regular employees are working on 07 posts. To compensate the shortage, as many as 05 contractual employees are working on various posts in the college.

The Library provides a welcoming, serene and spacious ambiance to facilitate self-study. The daily issue-return average of the students is 60-70 percent.
